Housing Organization opens new building for low income families

Seattle's own Housing Organization is scheduled to open their newest home for low-income families that will help reduce the waitlist for other homes and reduce temporary housing.

Seattle, WA –Housing Organization Homes opened to great fanfare today as the latest development in the community to provide safe, decent, affordable homes for 35 families in two- and three-bedroom apartments. Housing Organization Homes is rented up and already has a waitlist of 15 families.

“The economic situation is so difficult for families in our community, and we are seeing more homelessness than ever,” said Ed Rector, Executive Director of Housing Organization. “We are very excited to be able to provide this needed resource in our community, but we find ourselves unable to keep up with the demand for homes from low income working families like the ones moving into Housing Organization Homes today.”

The Housing Organization strives to provide a safe place for low-income families in the Seattle area, and the newest building has been under construction for over two years. Funded by the Washington State Housing Trust Fund, private lenders, and donors from the Seattle community, Housing Organization Homes is truly a community partnership.

The benefits of affordable housing like Housing Organization Homes go beyond just providing security to those in need. “Housing Organization Homes is putting more eyes on the street and changing our neighborhood for the better,” said Jane Dough, a business owner whose shop is across the street from Housing Organization Homes. “Two years ago, that was a vacant lot. It wasn't good for business. But with Housing Organization Homes there, business is already better and my customers tell me they feel safer parking and walking here.”
